

BACK TO SCHOOL ACTIVITY

(Could be used as a Young Women or Relief Society Activity)

Ideas: Make up a "hall pass" looking invite - hand out the Sunday before the activity. The Sunday before the activity, hand out their "class schedules" based on the classes they signed up for. Each class could be 20-30 minutes long. They will choose from one of two "1st Period" classes and one of two "2nd Period" classes.

"1st Period" classes are:

1) Arithmetic (Financial Do's and Don'ts)

With this class invite a banker or other financial professional in our ward or neighborhood to come and talk about ways to save money, get out of debt, faster ways to pay off loans, etc.

2) Reading (Children's Literature)

In this class the Sister's will learn fun ways to share stories with children, ways to spice up a story, and ways to teach your children from stories. (Have a teacher teach this class)

After the "1st Period" class ring the bell in the church and then the Sisters will attend one of the "2nd Period" classes.

"2nd Period" classes are:

1) Home EC. 101 (Homemade Halloween Costumes)

You can have someone who knows about this teach or do a search on the internet for easy homemade costumes. Teach us ways to make homemade costumes for Halloween.

2) Home EC. 102 (Canning Yummies in a Jar)

This class will teach how to can the comfort food we all like. Cakes in a jar, cookie mixes, soup mixes, etc . . . Do a search on the internet for jar mixes, or cookies in a jar, etc . . .

At the end of the night hand out diplomas and should anyone be late to class hand out tardy slips and send them to detention (clean-up after).

Refreshments could be cafeteria foods such as wrapped sandwiches, bagged chips, milk in school cartons and a wrapped brownie. They will be served on paper trays.
