

# Who Wants to be a Celestialheir?

## *Priesthood Edition*

### **How to play:**

**Set Up:** In advance make a set of 6 cards for each young woman, 3 letter cards labeled A, B, C and 3 lifeline cards. Get appropriate pictures of members of the First Presidency and 12 Apostles (see questions). Ask an energetic person to host the game. Set up a table and chairs at the front of the room (enough seats for half of your young women), a small table or podium for the host and a row of chairs for the audience (enough seats for half of your young women). Have prizes ready.

**Lifelines:** A girl can use a lifeline if she doesn't know the answer to a question. The lifelines are "Ask a Friend" (ask another young woman), "Ask a Wise Woman" (ask a leader) and "Ask the Audience." If they "Ask the Audience" after everyone else as placed their answer cards down on the table the host will ask the audience to hold up their answers (the young women all have their A, B, C cards with them). Another fun lifeline you can use instead of "Ask a Friend" would be "Ask a Young Man." You can have young men present or since the young men are usually having their own activity at the same time, pre-arrange for them to have a cell phone with them that you can call them on that night. However, this may not be a good option for a large group because it would take too much time.

**Teams:** Divide the young women in half. Half will play a round while the other half is audience members (the reason for this is two fold, so players can "ask the audience," and so if a young woman is knocked out of a round early she doesn't feel singled out sitting alone).

**How to Play:** Have the girls who are playing that round sit down at the tables with their 6 cards in front of them. The host will then ask them the questions for that round. The questions are designed to go from easiest to hardest. It is helpful to have a leader write the choices on a chalk board for the young women to see. After a few moments the host will have the young women put out the card that has their answer (A, B, or C) face down out in front of them on the table. At this time, if a young woman wants to use a lifeline, rather than putting out an answer card she should hold the lifeline card she wants to use in the air. The host then takes the lifeline card and directs each girl who wants a lifeline to either quietly go and ask a friend of her choice, ask a leader of her choice (not the host), or if she wants to ask the audience then she needs to wait until the very end. When the young women using the "ask friend" or "ask wise woman" lifelines have put out their answer cards, then if a young woman wants to ask the audience, the host asks the audience for their answer (this way, all the other young women who are not asking the audience are already committed to their answer because they have already put their answers down on the table, no matter what the audience says). The young women in the audience, without talking to each other, hold up the letter card they think is the right answer. After all the playing young women have their answer cards face down in front

of them on the table, the host will ask them to reveal their answers. Then the host will give them the correct answer and dismiss any young women to the audience who answered the question incorrectly.

**Prizes:** There are three prize levels in the game. After the 4<sup>th</sup> question, a prize basket is passed to all the girls still in the game. This can be a small candy like a chocolate kiss. After the 7<sup>th</sup> question, another prize basket is passed to all the girls still in the game. This is a larger prize, like a fun sized candy bar. Any young women answering all 10 questions gets to choose a large prize, like a candy bar. After a round is finished a small prize is also given to all participating audience members.

**Commercial Breaks:** It is helpful, whenever the girls get noisy, or loose focus, to have a “commercial break.” We would ask a young women to stand to the front and lead the girls in a camp song or fun primary song. This also gave the host a chance for a glass of water. You could plan cute commercial breaks in advance if you are ambitious.

**The Questions:** Some of the following questions have come from the lesson manual; others have come from my own head. You will need to fill in some of the questions for you own ward, such as: who is the elder’s quorum president. The answer for the picture questions will very depending on what pictures you can obtain. I think the questions about the presidents of the Aaronic priesthood in you ward are important so the girls realize that the Young Men they associate with are priesthood holders and leaders in the priesthood.

We did this activity after the Sunday lessons on the Priesthood. It was very successful and the girls had fun.
